Dave and Janet Schumacher and Carolyn and Dave Tegeler made a coordination trip on February 17, 2007 to do some preplanning and iron out some details with the City Manager and the Chief of Police regarding the charity drives and to meet with Tom Morris at the Fireside restaurant to discuss menu and costs. The mayor has once again selected the Friends of Haystack Rock as the charity with our endorsement and we saw the NEW Aluminum and Stainless trailer last year's event substantially funded. This year our contributions will help fund obtaining a tow vehicle. We learned the whole town is looking forward to our visit and the charity rides this year, so let's make this event even better than last year.

The schedule is like last year with the Seattle and Portland factions arriving on Friday with car washing between arrival and 5:30 pm and then a wine and cheese event between 5:30-7 pm in the conference room in the Pool building. Dinner Friday is open agenda, trying to patronize the Ecola seafoods store next to the Fireside restaurant.

Saturday, plan to tour the Art galleries as this is opening weekend for them. Charity rides will be offered between 2:30 to 4:30 allowing those supporting charity rides a half hour to reposition for the street show. The street show will be between 5-7 pm with a club sponsored wine and cheese event at the community center. The club dinner with a small charity auction and prizes will be held between 7-9:00 pm in the community center. If there are more than 88 people attending the later registrants will use the Banquet room in the Fireside (last year there were 115)

Friday will be BYOB and BYO Cheese and Crackers. The cost for the Wine and Cheese Saturday and the Prime Rib and Salmon Dinner and all the incidentals to put on this event is \$45 per person. We have a contract with the Hallmark for a block of 60 rooms so it would make sense to place your reservations now by calling 503-436-1566 and tell them your with the Ferrari group. As of this writing we have 14 rooms reserved one of three houses we have reserved. I'll be issuing a roster as before and cross-checking Hotel reservations with those who will be attending the dinner. All who want to attend this event need to make their reservations before March 15, 2007 as we will have to release available rooms after that to avoid a cancellation penalty. Our hotel is in high demand as this is the same weekend as the spring unveiling by the Arts Community.


